## Minimum Entry Criteria for Courses and Apprenticeships

Our minimum entry criteria may be altered at any stage up to and including enrolment. All offers are subject to a successful interview and completion of an initial and diagnostic assessment. Some courses have additional course specific entry criteria and / or require the completion of a specialist pre-entry test; these are shown on the relevant course information page on the college website. In addition to the criteria below, some courses require relevant occupational experience.
