

<b>Course:</b>	<b>Construction Skills Qualifications NVQ Level 2 in Plastering (Solid Plastering - Basic)</b>
<b>This course is for:</b>	Skilled operatives who are involved in the application of finished plaster to background surfaces. This qualification has a two-tier approach to Level 2. It allows candidates to achieve Level 2 at a level defined as 'Basic Option' or at the 'Full Option' level. 'Basic' reflects the fact that many plastering operatives are limited in the scope of their work by the limited range of plastering work their company undertakes. The 'Basic' level thus allows the NVQ candidate to achieve an NVQ Level 2 that reflects their restricted range of skills. The qualification is recognised by both employers and clients involved in this type of work in the construction and allied industries.
<b>Employer benefits:</b>	Employees will develop increased confidence and be able to perform to the highest standards in the construction industry.
<b>Length of course:</b>	This course will run for 6 to 9 months depending on the candidate's ability to facilitate appropriate assessment opportunities.
<b>Mandatory units:</b>	Conform to general workplace safety. Conform to efficient work practices. Move and handle resources. Apply Finishing Plaster to Background Surfaces.
<b>Optional units:</b>	Produce Internal Solid Plastering Finishes. Produce External Solid Render Finishes. Install Direct Bond Dry Linings. Lay Sand and Cement Screeds. Apply Projection Plaster and Maintain Equipment. Install Mechanically fixed Plasterboard.
<b>Location of study:</b>	Workplace assessment.
<b>How to enrol:</b>	Contact us for more information.
<b>Entry requirements:</b>	You must be at least 19 years of age and in employment as a plasterer and have achieved the Intermediate Construction Award in Plastering. You may be asked to take a literacy assessment.

- Progression:** Skilled operatives can progress to chargehand/supervisory positions within their organisations. They can with further training and experience progress attain a level 3 qualification within the other plastering occupations routes and progress to supervisory, technical and management positions within their organisations.
- Cost:** This course is offered under the Train to Gain Programme. Training is free to individuals who meet the eligibility criteria for the Train to Gain programme. For eligibility criteria, telephone 020 7501 5313.
- Award:** Upon successful completion of this programme, learners will receive a Level 2 NVQ in Plastering (Solid Plastering - Basic), a vocationally recognised qualification.
