

Course:	Construction Skills Qualifications NVQ Level 3 in Wood Occupations (Bench Joinery)
This course is for:	Skilled operatives who are involved in the installation and maintenance of light timber framing in the construction and wood occupations sector wishing to attain a nationally recognised qualification. The qualification is recognised by both employers and clients involved in this type of work in the construction and allied industries.
Employer benefits:	Employees will develop increased confidence and be able to perform to the highest standards in the construction industry.
Length of course:	This course will run for 6 to 9 months depending on the candidate's ability to facilitate appropriate assessment opportunities.
Mandatory units:	Conform to general workplace safety. Confirm work activities and resources for the work. Develop and maintain good working relationships. Confirm the occupational method of work. Produce setting out details for routine products. Mark out from setting out details for routine products. Manufacture routine products. Manufacture complex shaped products.
Optional units:	Set Up and Use Fixed or Transportable Machinery. Produce Complex Shaped Product Details. Produce CAD Setting Out Details.
Location of study:	Workplace assessment.
How to enrol:	Contact us for more information.
Entry requirements:	You must be at least 19 years of age, be in employment as a site carpenter with supervisory responsibilities and have achieved the Advanced Construction Award in Carpentry & Joinery. You may be asked to take a literacy assessment.
Progression:	As part of lifelong learning we encourage learner progression. This qualification features multiple options routes. The bulk of candidates are likely to select just one route, as this reflects their typical day to day skills. However, if their work skills broaden out over time, they may be able to achieve other

associated routes. If a candidate wanted to progress they could opt to undertake Construction Site Supervision at Level 3, if their work allowed.

The qualification offers employment opportunities as learners are demonstrating occupational competence by qualification achievement.

Cost: This course is offered under the Train to Gain Programme. Training is free to individuals who meet the eligibility criteria for the Train to Gain programme. For eligibility criteria, telephone 020 7501 5313.

Award: Upon successful completion of this programme, learners will receive a Level 3 NVQ in Wood Occupations (Bench Joinery), a vocationally recognised qualification.
