What is a Sector Based Work Academy?

A Sector Based Work Academy (SWAP) is an intense sector specific course, which has been individually designed with an employer to provide specific industry-based training and job opportunities to people who are unemployed and claiming benefits.

Participants will remain on their benefits throughout the duration of the course. The Jobcentre may also offer support for travel and childcare costs during the training.
